



## Regulation No. 8, Part B - Update FAQ

Revisions to Colorado Regulation No. 8, Part B, that were adopted by the Air Quality Control Commission on January 22, 2021 (herein referred to as the “Revised Regulation”) will be effective March 17, 2021. The following are answers to frequently asked questions concerning how the revisions will be implemented.

### PERMITS

1. Permitted projects, including changes or amendments to the Division-approved project, with an approved project start date before March 17, 2021, must be done under the requirements of the previous regulation effective January 8, 2008. New phases, meaning new work added to the permit on or after March 17, 2021 must meet the requirements of the Revised Regulation.
2. For projects with an approved start date on or after March 17, 2021, regardless of the date the notification application is submitted, the requirements of the Revised Regulation will apply.
3. For projects with an approved start date before March 17, 2021, which are modified to begin on a date on or after March 17, 2021, please contact the Permit Coordinator as the requirements will differ based on the relevant circumstances.

### PROJECT DESIGNS

1. Designs for projects that have an approved project start date before March 17, 2021, must be completed under the requirements of the previous regulation effective January 8, 2008.
2. Designs for projects that have an approved project start date on or after March 17, 2021, must meet the requirements of the Revised Regulation.

### INSPECTIONS

1. Inspections during which samples were collected before March 17, 2021, the inspections and reports are subject to the requirements of the previous regulation effective January 8, 2008.
2. Inspections during which samples are collected on or after March 17, 2021, the inspections and reports are subject to the requirements of the Revised Regulation.

### EXAMS

For exam applicants: if you did not pass an asbestos certification exam in any discipline, you must take a refresher class if this is your first failure or take an initial class if this is a second failure (or more) in order to schedule an exam retake on or after March 17, 2021.

There are four new forms (Instructor Application, Request for Asbestos Building Inspection Exemption, Major Asbestos Spill Reporting Form and Waiver of the 10-Working Day Notification Period Request) that must be used on or after March 17, 2021.
