Completed packets will assist the Program in completing your application, incomplete packets will be returned. Training providers, please continue to use this same email address for class notifications, cancellations and other training course related documents. The IEP encourages all certified individuals, companies and registered entities to start their renewal process 30 days before they expire to ensure there is no disruption in their employment status or business affairs.
